Our mission in these difficult times is to provide all possible assistance to the affected population, create conditions for the sustainable development of society, and spread charitable activities.



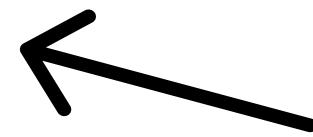

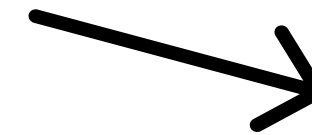

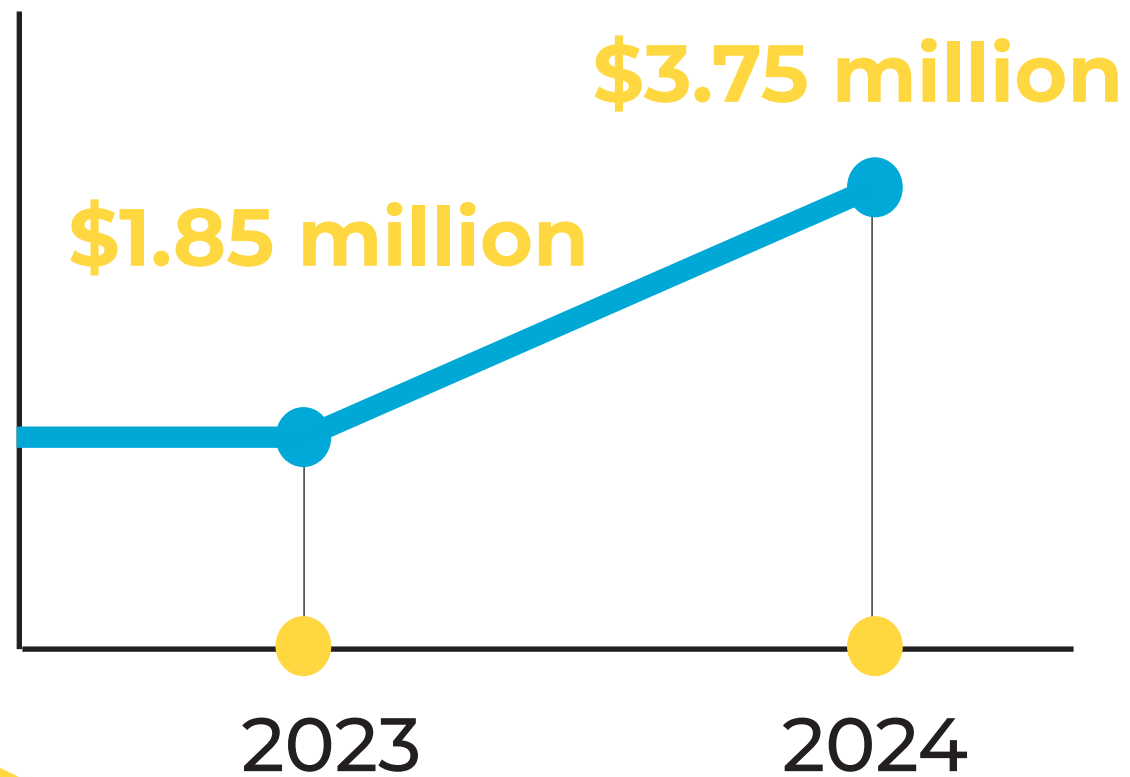

Compared to 2023, the volume of project financing and their number have doubled.

FINANCIAL INDICATORS

Projects in progress - **8**

Assistance was provided in the amount of **more than UAH 157 million.**

Paid taxes - **more than UAH 5.5 million.**

Shchedryk regularly reports on its activities to philanthropists, government agencies, and Ukrainian society.

Regular reports on our daily work are published on our official website and social media pages.

We generate financial reports in two directions:

1) reports to our donors - are prepared within the timeframe and in the format required by our donor and partner organizations, and are sent to them in accordance with signed agreements.

2) reports to tax authorities - are prepared in accordance with the deadlines and volumes approved by Ukrainian legislation.

OUR PARTNERS



The name of the project is “Center for Assistance and Provision of Livelihood Opportunities”.

The project aims to provide access to protection services, referrals and advice on social benefits, and improve access to livelihood opportunities through vocational training and small business support for the affected population.

The project period is **August 2023 - January 2025.**

The project budget is **620 thousand euros.**

- The professions most in demand by the market and people have been identified, found the best educational institutions.
- Training was provided to 4 groups (total number of 51 participants) on the following areas: baker, manicurist, web designer, tailor.
- Additional training was provided to improve the skills of 2 groups for areas: manicurist and tailor.
- Training has begun for 2 groups (total number of 40 beneficiaries) in the following areas: bus driver and trolleybus driver.



Conducting business planning training and providing small grants.

- For the 1st stage of the project - selection and training were carried out (60 beneficiaries) and providing small grants for 35 participants.
- For the 2nd stage of the project – 30 beneficiaries were selected for conducting business planning training.
- Upon completion of the training, participants' business plans were reviewed, A selection was made for the provision of small grants for 24 beneficiaries.

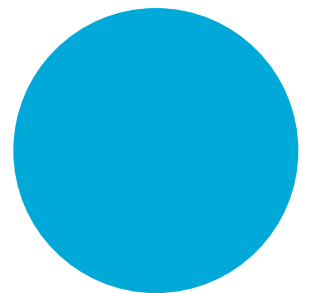

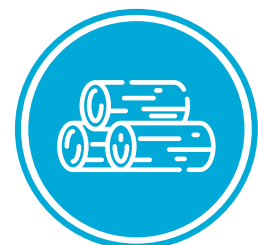

ASSISTANCE FOR HEATING YOUR HOME

The goal of the project is to provide necessary assistance to the most vulnerable segments of the population of the Kherson and Mykolaiv regions by providing them with firewood for heating their homes in the winter.

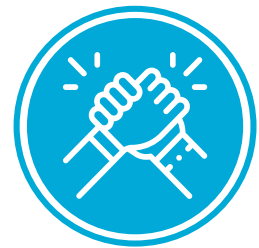
- **Cash grants provided:** 514 households (525 USD equivalent).
- **Distribution of solid fuels** in natural form 650 households to meet the winter energy needs of the most vulnerable, affected by the war in the Kherson region (Kalynivska TG).
- **The volume of assistance** is 5.26 cubic meters of solid fuel.
- **Budget** ~ UAH 15 million

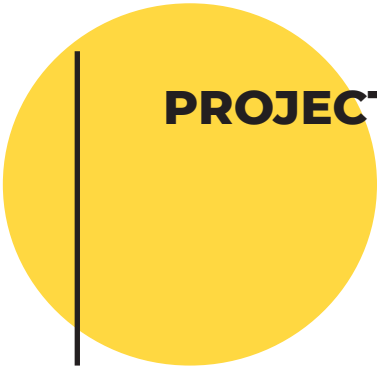

“INFORMED-PROTECTED” PROJECT (TOGETHER WITH IRC)

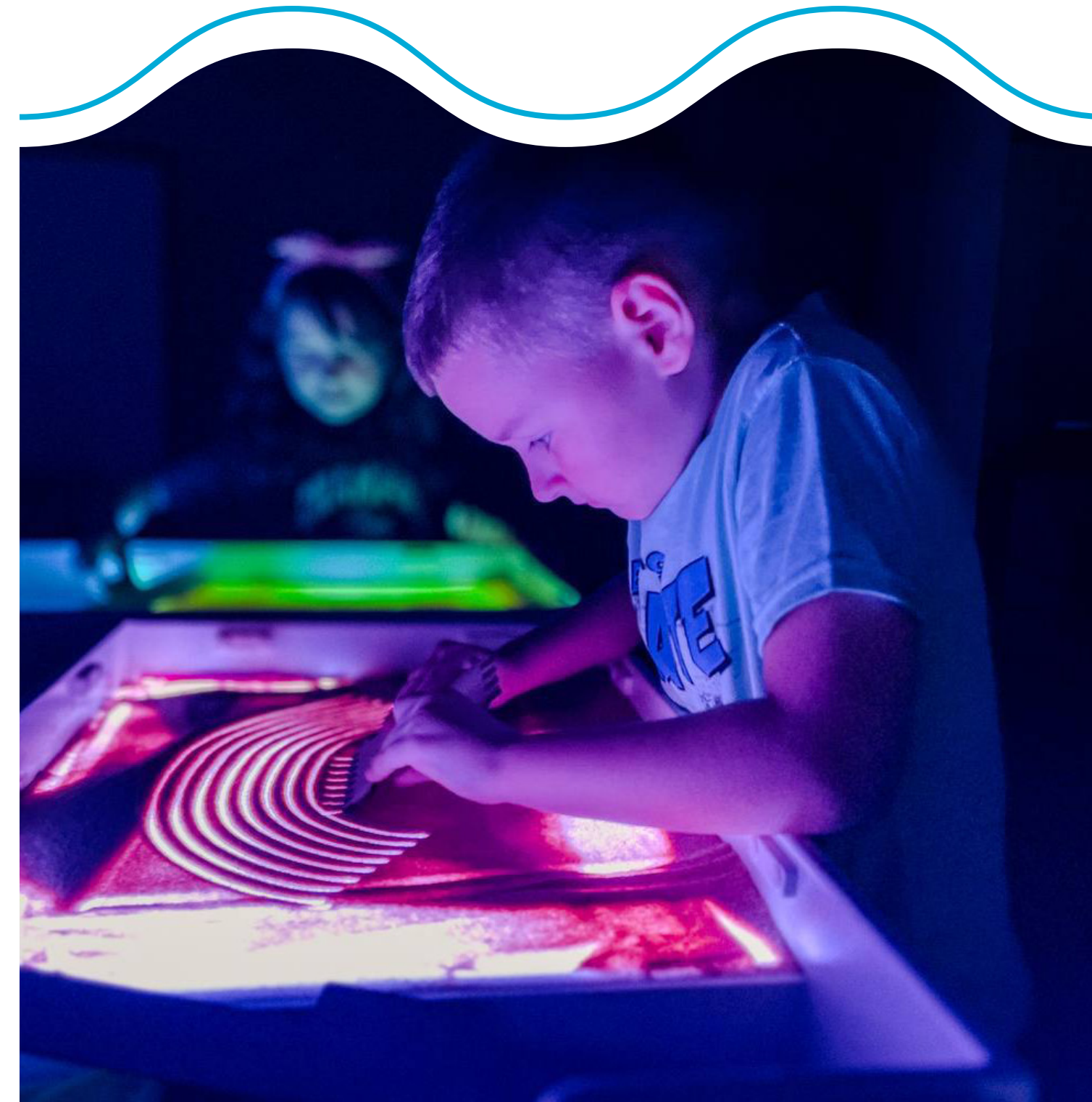
200 children and adolescents attended one-time psychosocial support sessions (art therapy, holiday performances, competitions).

200 children and adolescents from Mykolaiv and Kherson regions received psychosocial support services under the “Socio- Emotional Learning” and “SAFE” programs.

115 parents and guardians underwent group psychosocial support sessions and the “Positive Parenting” program.

Project locations: Voskresenska TG, Vesnianska TG, Bereznehuvatska TG, Pervomaiska TG, Chornobaivska TG, Shevchenkivska TG, Chornobaivska TG.

Our goal is to rehabilitate children in social life, organize their interaction with peers, help them master certain amounts of knowledge, skills, and abilities, develop their personality, and integrate them into society.

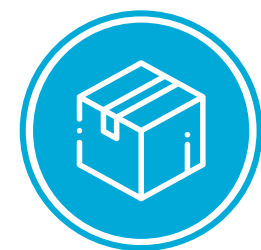

30 thousand canned goods were distributed (more than 10 tons);



400 thousand food kits were distributed (more than 5,000 tons);

- Purchase of equipment for argon arc welding (welder tables, welding machines, ventilation system and other auxiliary materials)
- Development of training programs by qualification area “Argon arc welding”
- Conducting professional and practical training for students
- Summing up the results of the project implementation - conducting “Round Table”

The charity foundation's stationary offices are located in 4 locations in Mykolaiv.

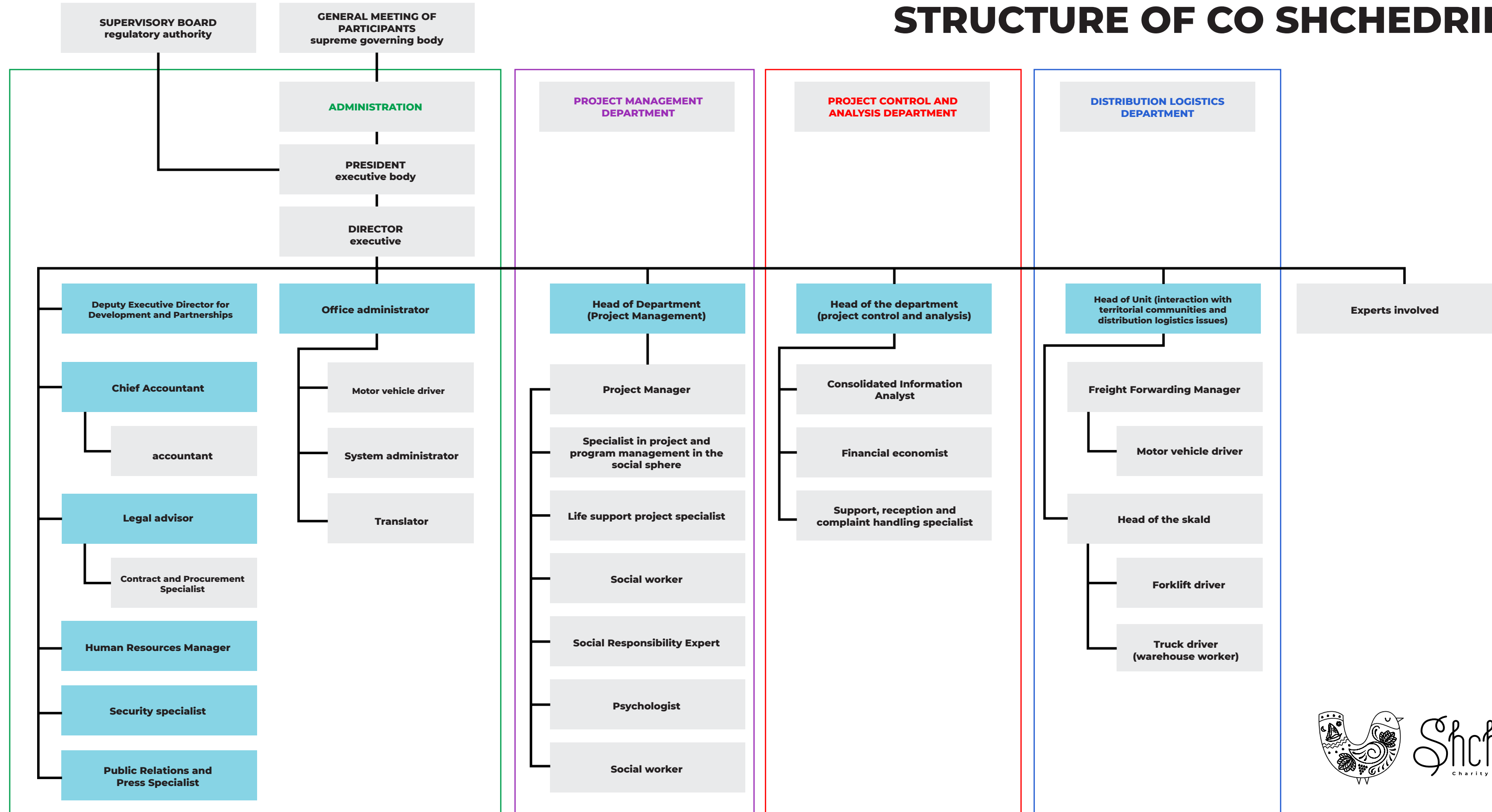


We rent warehouses in Mykolaiv and Kherson (~1000 sq m).
