The charitable organisation “Shchedryk Charitable Foundation” was established in July 2022.

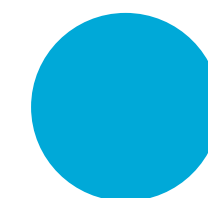
The co-founders of the foundation are Nataliia Horbenko, Olexandr Mosin, and Sergii Kolesnyk.

Our main goal is:

- to develop regions by ensuring protection, equal opportunities and the satisfaction of every person’s needs;
- to provide comprehensive support to vulnerable populations.

Every person should have the opportunity to fulfil their needs, so it is important to develop regions by creating conditions for access to necessary resources, services, and opportunities at the local level.

Currently, the Shchedryk’s team has focused its efforts on helping the population of southern Ukraine (Mykolaiv and Kherson regions).

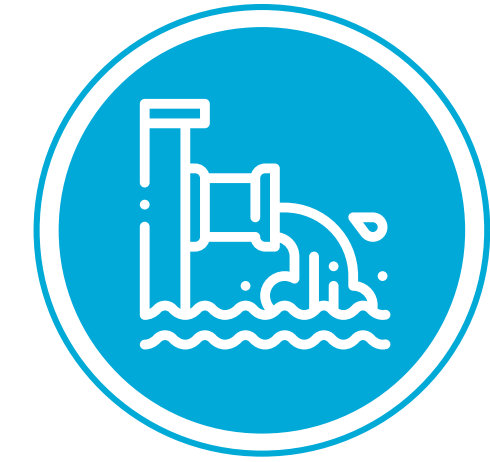

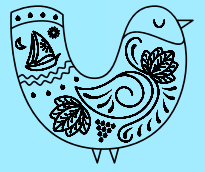

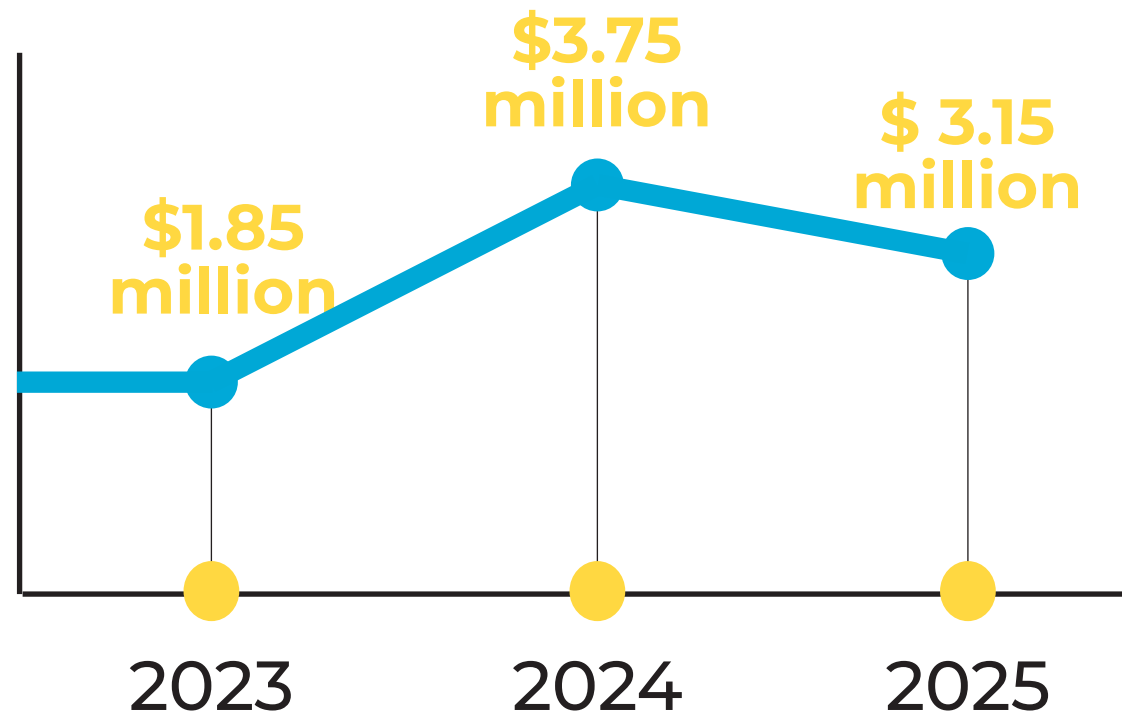

FINANCIAL RESULTS



Compared to 2024, funding was decreased by 16%.

Projects in progress - **10**

Received funding and assistance provided - **more than 140 million UAH**

Taxes paid - **more than 9.1 million UAH**

Shchedryk regularly reports on its activities to donors, partners, government agencies and Ukrainian society.

Daily reports are published on the official pages of the foundation's website and social networks.

Financial reports are provided:

- 1) Reports to our donors/partners** are prepared in accordance with the deadlines and format required by our donor and partner organisations and sent to them in accordance with the signed agreements (monthly).
- 2) Reports to tax authorities** are prepared in accordance with the deadlines and volumes approved by Ukrainian legislation.

OUR PARTNERS



The aim of the project is to ensure access to protection services, referrals for social benefits and advice on social benefits, and to improve access to livelihood opportunities through vocational trainings and small business support for affected populations.

Duration: August 2023 – July 2025.

The project budget is €1,258,000.

PROJECT “ASSISTANCE CENTRE AND ENABLING OPPORTUNITIES FOR EXISTENCE” IN COOPERATION WITH OXFAM



The professions most in demand by the market and people were identified, and the best educational institutions (universities and vocational colleges) were found. State-approved diplomas and certificates of completion were issued.

- **6 groups** (a total of 96 participants) **were trained** in the following sectors: baker (employment at a bread factory), manicurist, web designer, tailor.
- **2 groups** (a total of 40 beneficiaries) **were trained** in the following sectors: bus driver and trolleybus driver. Employment at municipal enterprises Mykolaivelektrotrans and Mykolaivpastrans
- **Training in business planning and provision of small grants** (from €2,300 to €4,500). As a result, beneficiaries start their own businesses (registering as sole entrepreneurs) or expand and support existing businesses.



PROJECT “ASSISTANCE TO FRONT-LINE HOUSEHOLDS” IN COOPERATION WITH WFP

- **Duration:** April 2025 - March 2026.
- **7 communities in** Mykolaiv and Kherson regions;
- **Target: 3,380** households;
- **Motor blocks with attachments** – 735;
- **Greenhouse kits** – 318;
- **Drip irrigation kits** – 175;
- **Retraining** – 108 (bakers, tractor drivers, beauty industry);
- **Financial assistance** – 1,111 (700 USD);
- **Business grants:** 80 grants of \$5,000 each;
- **Agricultural training courses** (“Greenhouse cultivation”, “Plant growing and drip irrigation”, “Agrodrone operator”).



BUDGET ~ \$1.5 M.

PROJECT “INSTITUTIONAL STRENGTHENING” IN PARTNERSHIP WITH WFP

- **Duration:** May 2025 - December 2025.
- **Mykolaiv and Kherson regions;**
- **Food aid provided to ~ 75,000 beneficiaries;**
- **More than 450 tonnes distributed** in the form of food kits for cooking in various institutions (hospitals, shelters, geriatric nursing homes / hospices, neurological /psychoneurological/psychiatric institutions, institutions for people with disabilities and chronic diseases, boarding schools, rehabilitation centres) - more than 60 different institutions.



Budget ~ \$80k

PROJECT “INTEGRATED SUPPORT FOR HOUSING, LIVELIHOODS, AND MPCA FOR CONFLICT-AFFECTED POPULATIONS IN SOUTHERN UKRAINE” IN PARTNERSHIP WITH ZOA

- **Duration:** May 2025 - April 2026.
- **Mykolaiv region (Shevchenkivska TG) and Kherson region (Bilozerka TG);**
- **Support for 1,060 households** (860 livelihoods + 200 MPCA);
- **Agricultural trainings.**



Budget ~ \$106k

PROJECT “SERVICES FOR LIAISING AND COORDINATING WITH COMMUNITIES IN MICRO-DISTRICTS IN MYKOLAIV” IN COOPERATION WITH UNOPS



- **Duration:** April 2025 - January 2026.
- **Mykolaiv;**
- **7 apartment buildings** / 200 households;
- **Conducting a survey of beneficiaries who received assistance in the form of repairs to their homes after shelling** (windows, roofing, etc.).

Budget ~ \$37k

PROJECT “HAPPY AND STRONG” IN COOPERATION WITH THE YOUTH OF UKRAINE

- **Duration:** July 2025 - November 2025.
- **Mykolaiv;**
- **Target** 170 beneficiaries;
- **Conducting classes for children aimed at developing their critical thinking, emotional maturity, and social skills. Support and sessions on positive parenting. Conducting self-defence classes for women.**



Budget: 300,000 UAH.

PROJECT “NEW PROFESSION - NEW OPPORTUNITIES” IN COOPERATION WITH CORE

- **Duration:** August 2025 - December 2025.
- **Mykolaiv;**
- **Target** 17 beneficiaries;
- **Training of trolleybus drivers** (obtaining a state-approved T category licence) with subsequent employment at municipal Mykolaivelektrotrans.

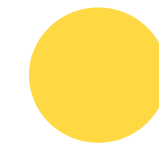

PROJECT “MYKOLAIV RECOVERED” IN COOPERATION WITH UNDP



- **Duration:** October 2025 - December 2025.
- **Mykolaiv region;**
- **Target** 15 beneficiaries;
- **Purchase and installation of polycarbonate greenhouses** (6m*15m=90 sq.m).



Budget ~\$81k

PROJECT “EMERGENCY WINTERIZATION SUPPORT FOR CONFLICT AFFECTED POPULATION IN KHERSON REGION” IN COOPERATION WITH ERC



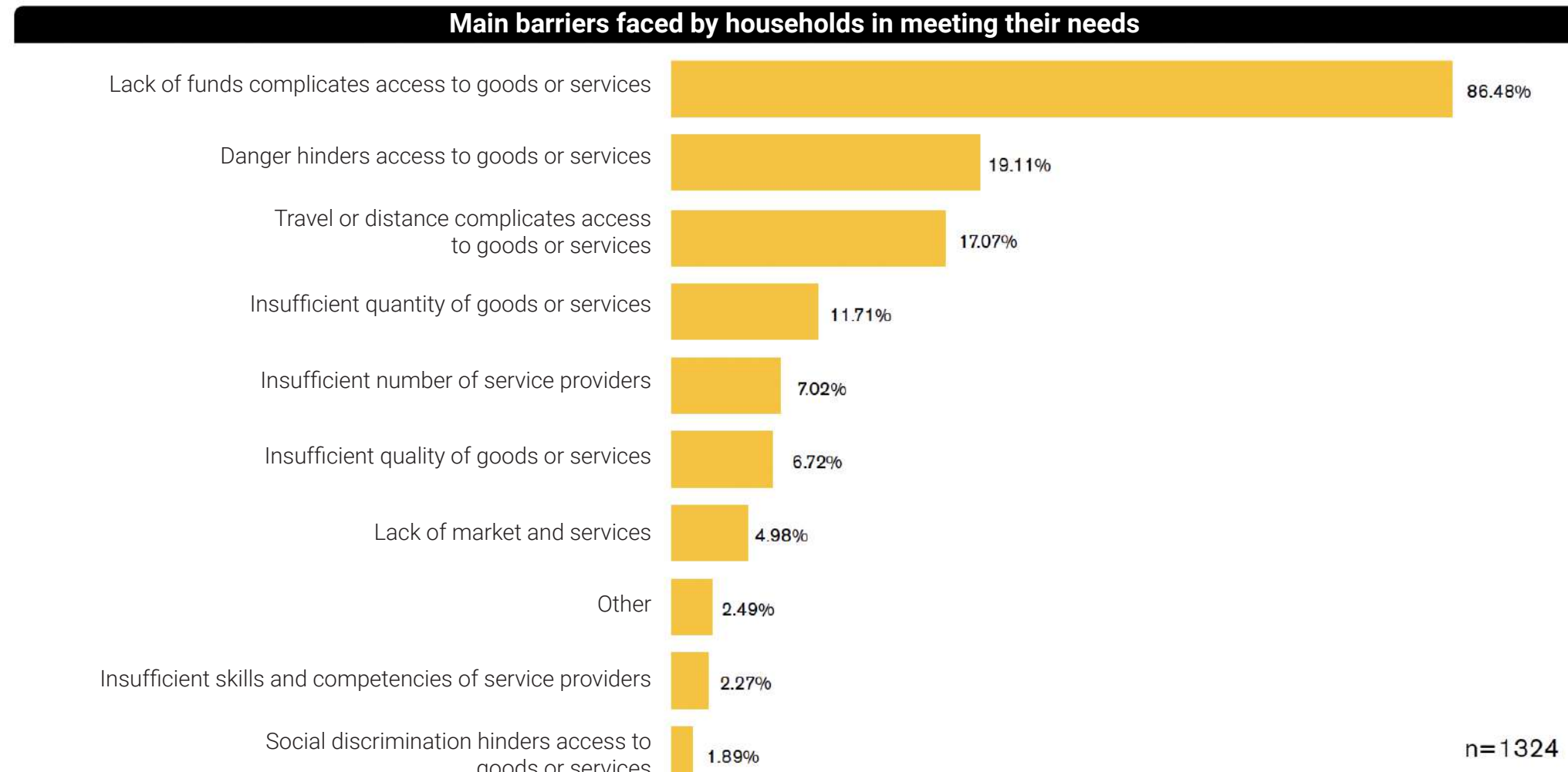
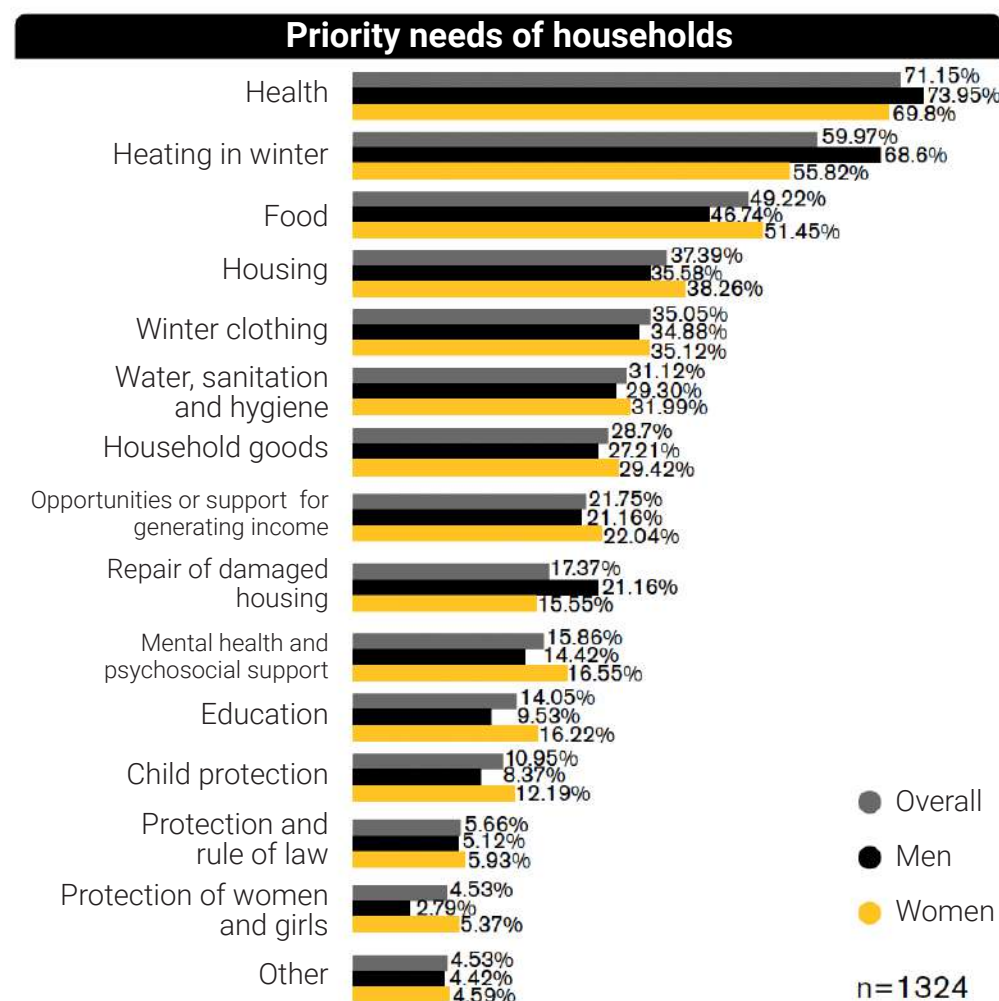
- **Duration:** October 2025 - February 2025.
- **Kherson region** (Velyka Oleksandrivka TG);
- **Target:** 250 households;
- **Provision of solid fuel in kind (~5 cubic metres)** to vulnerable groups of the population.

Budget ~\$197k

In 2025, as part of our cooperation with the IRC, a multi-sectoral protection needs assessment was conducted:

- more than 200 households;
- Mykolaiv and Kherson regions.

We constantly monitor needs together with our partners.





Audit by the international company Crowe for 2024. Successfully passed. Compliance with current legislation and transparency of financial reporting confirmed.



Opened a branch (legal registration) of the Shchedryk Charitable Foundation in Bulgaria (Burgas).



The Shchedryk Charitable Foundation received the status of a critically important humanitarian organisation from the Ministry of Development of Communities and Territories of Ukraine and was included in the relevant register. This has enabled the foundation to defer its employees from mobilization.



CO “CF Shchedryk” is a sub-coordinator of FSLC (Food Security and Livelihoods Cluster) in the Mykolaiv region. Active participant in the coordination of HOCCG (south), ABC (Kherson) and NGO Platforma.



The reconstruction of the administrative building and the opening of the Assistance Centre in the Korabelnyi district of Mykolaiv (with shelter and backup power supply) have been completed.



The Shchedryk's team consists of qualified specialists under strong leadership and has more than 60 permanent employees (officially employed).

Employees share the core values of the United Nations and are guided by the following humanitarian principles: **humanity, neutrality, impartiality and independence.**

All employees undergo regular training and professional development.



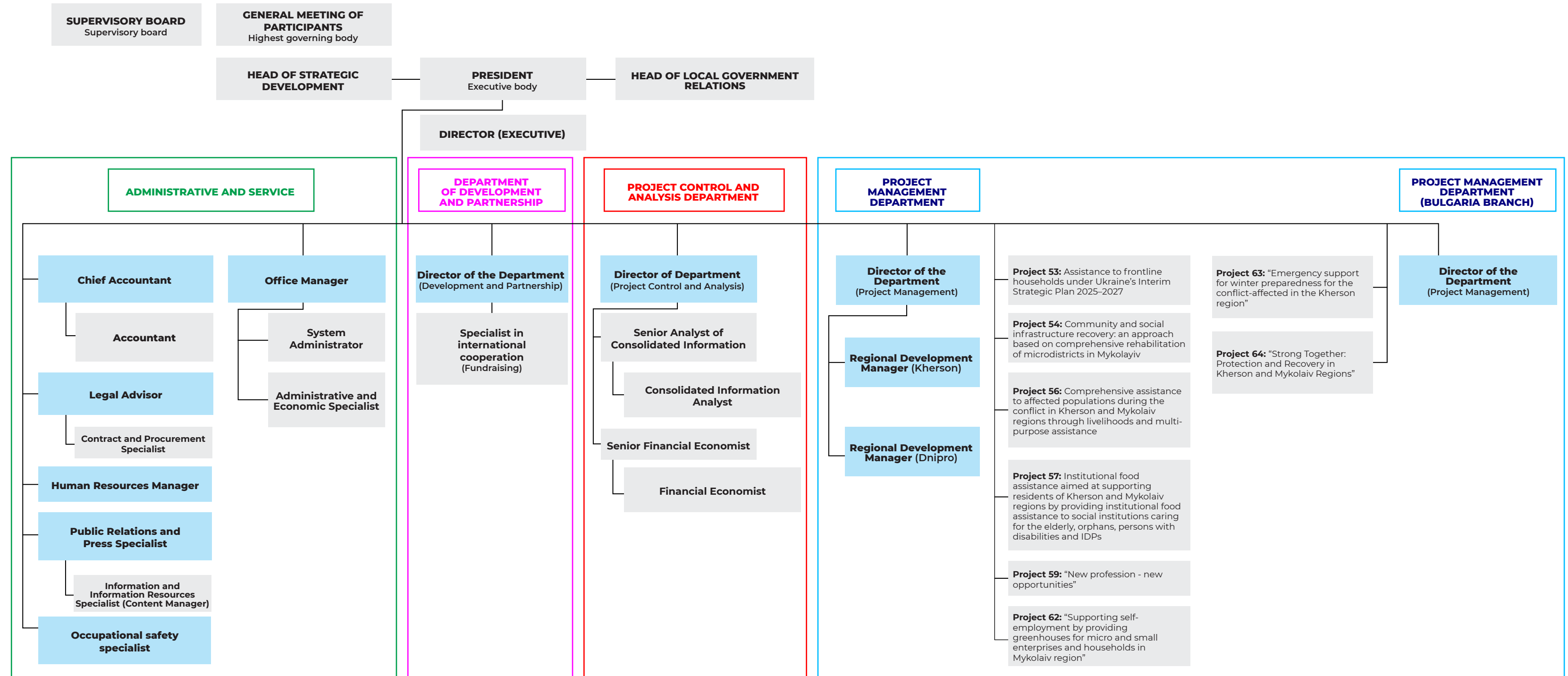
The charity fund's permanent offices are located in Mykolaiv and Kherson.



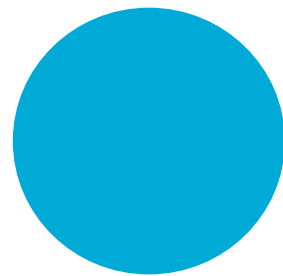
Warehouse facility in Mykolaiv (~300 sq. m.).
